TAKE NOTICE that a petition has been presented to the High Court by the directors of MetLife Europe Insurance DAC ("**MetLife Insurance**") and the directors of Nationale-Nederlanden Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń S.A. ("**NN Poland**") seeking the sanction by the Court under section 13 of the Assurance Companies Act 1909 and Regulation 41 of the European Union (Insurance and Reinsurance) Regulations 2015 of a Scheme for the transfer of a portfolio of certain non-life assurance business from MetLife Insurance to NN Poland.

Pursuant to an Order of the Court made on 30 January 2023, copies of the Scheme, the petition, this notice and the report of the Independent Actuary are available for inspection at [www.metlife.eu](http://www.metlife.eu) or [www.nn.pl](http://www.nn.pl) or, during normal business hours from Mondays to Fridays, public holidays excepted, at the offices identified below, from 3 February 2023 until 22 March 2023.

The petition is to be heard by way of a hybrid hearing (meaning it will be heard physically and remotely at the same time) at 11.00 am on 22 March 2023. Any person who may be entitled to be heard may appear at the hearing in person at the Four Courts, Dublin 7, remotely by way of the High Court's virtual courtroom or by way of counsel or solicitor appearing in person or remotely. Any person who intends to so appear, and any policyholder who objects to the Scheme and wishes to record that objection but does not intend so to appear, should give written notice of such intention or dissent, and the reasons therefor, to McCann FitzGerald LLP, solicitors for MetLife Insurance, (Ref: SEB/DDOC), Riverside One, Sir John Rogerson's Quay, Dublin 2, Ireland, or by email to [seb@mcf.ie](mailto:seb@mcf.ie) or [ddoc@mcf.ie](mailto:ddoc@mcf.ie), not later than 5:00 pm on 10 March 2023. If any such person wishes to rely on any affidavit on the hearing of the petition, a copy of such affidavit should be served on the solicitors for MetLife Insurance not later than 5:00 pm on 10 March 2023.
