Information on Personal Data Processing

Who is Your Data Controller

Nationale-Nederlanden Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń na Życie S.A. is the Controller of your personal data.

If you have given marketing consent, your personal data – as co-controllers – is managed by entities of the Nationale-Nederlanden Group, with its registered office in Warsaw (00-342) at ul. Topiel 12:

Why Do We Need Your Personal Information

We process your personal information to:

- Conclude and execute the insurance contract, including claim settlement. This involves the processing of data contained in the documents you send to us, including medical documents.
- Evaluate insurance risks before entering into a contract with you.
- Pursue a complaint that is related to your contract, which is our legitimate legal interest.
- Counteract Anti-Money Laundering and the Financing of Terrorism. The regulations require us to check for circumstances that would prevent us from entering
 into an insurance contract with you.
- Analyse concluded contracts in terms of preventing insurance crimes. This constitutes our legitimate interest in preventing insurance crimes.
- Carry out the obligations that are imposed on us by generally applicable laws.
- Defend against possible claims that are related to the insurance contract.
- Process your personal data for marketing purposes and address marketing communications regarding our products to you if you have given the appropriate
 consents.

Your provision of data is voluntary, but necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract and the risk assessment. Provision of data for marketing purposes is voluntary.

Who Can Access Your Data

We may transfer your data to other entities (recipients). We do this to properly execute the contract and ensure that the company is properly organised.

Recipients will be, in particular:

- IT solution providers,
- entities that support us in the process of claims settlement and debt collection,
- insurance agents,
- reinsurance companies,
- call center,
- marketing agencies and companies.

We have entered into agreements with each of these entities, in which we have imposed obligations on them related to the processing and protection of your data. Some of these entities may be based outside the European Economic Area. We send data to these countries based on a decision issued by the European Commission or standard contractual clauses. You have the right to receive copies of these clauses. To do so, you can send a request to: iod@nn.pl.

What are your rights in relation to data processing

In relation to the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:

- you have the right to access your data and you can request that we correct it, for example, if you find an error in it, or if you change your phone number or address;
- you have the right to be forgotten so you can request that we delete your data;
- you may file a so-called objection to the processing of your data, including for marketing purposes;
- you may request that we restrict data processing;
- you can receive your personal data from us we will transfer it in a commonly readable format (e.g. PDF) to you or to another data controller you indicate;
- you can file a complaint with the supervisory authority that deals with the protection of personal data. In Poland, this authority is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

Automated Decision-making

In order to prepare an appropriate offer and assess insurance risks, some decisions are made by automated means, i.e. without human involvement. We use for this purpose all data that you provide to us in your contract application or that we have obtained in connection with the conclusion and execution of other insurance contracts. Based on this information, we assess the risk and prepare an offer for you.

The methods we use for evaluation are subject to regular testing to ensure their impartiality, fairness and effectiveness. Each time you have the right to:

- get clarification on the basis of the decision we issued,
- express their position and to challenge our decision,
- get human intervention.

Consent Withdrawal

We process your data for marketing purposes from the moment we get your consent to do so until you withdraw it. You can do it at any time. Just remember that any information sent to you until the withdrawal of consent have been transferred in a lawful manner.

Data Processing Period

Your personal data will be processed until:

- the statute of limitations for claims under the insurance contract and other claims, or
- data retention obligations under the law will expire. In particular, the obligation to keep accounting documents that relate to the insurance contract.
